Legal Basis

This sworn statement is presented in terms of the interim order of the High Court of South Africa, Gauteng Division, Pretoria, in Sakeliga NPC and Others v Minister of Agriculture and Others, Case No. 2026-047152 (judgment and draft order dated 25 May 2026), clause 1.4, detailing compliance with Regulations 17(1)(c) and 18 of the Animal Diseases Regulations (and any amendments thereto), and including written proof after administering FMD vaccine to livestock, as set out below.

Statement of Notice and Vaccination

The deponent states that prior written notice of the intended vaccination was given to Dr Palesa Mthembu (State Veterinarian) as required by clause 1.1 of the order (see Annexure A), and that the FMD vaccine was thereafter administered to the livestock listed in Annexure B, on the dates and in the manner set out there.

Regulations 17(1)(c) and 18 Compliance

The deponent confirms that the FMD vaccine administered was lawfully imported or lawfully manufactured, that it was procured and administered by or under the direction of the owner/manager named below, and that the particulars set out in this statement and its annexures – the cold-chain evidence, the vaccine batch and product evidence, and the individual animal identification records – together detail the deponent’s compliance with Regulations 17(1)(c) and 18 of the Animal Diseases Regulations.

Cold-Chain Preservation Summary (clause 1.4.2)

Portable fridge, 2-8°C, dispatch-to-site under 3 hours. Actual temperatures recorded at administration ranged from 5°C to 5°C across 1 administration(s); see Annexure D for full detail.

Vaccine brand(s) used: FMD Vaccine. Dose, method and route for each animal are set out in Annexure B; batch and dosage instructions are set out in Annexure C.
