Proposed Cold-Chain Method

Fetch in styrofoam box with ice packs. Then use portable fridge to keep at a temperature of between 2 and 8 degrees.

Legal Basis

This notice is given in terms of the interim order of the High Court of South Africa, Gauteng Division, Pretoria, in Sakeliga NPC and Others v Minister of Agriculture and Others, Case No. 2026-047152 (judgment and draft order dated 25 May 2026), clause 1.1, which permits owners and managers of cloven-hooved livestock to procure and administer lawfully imported or lawfully manufactured FMD vaccines to their livestock, subject to the conditions set out in that order.
